<input type="checkbox"/> Hospitality Team Set up snack, welcome teens, manage nametag distribution and sign-in/out during the Sunday night program. - Sunday Nights (6:15-8:00pm)
- Mini-Workcamp (usually 1st Saturday of month)
- Small Faith Communities (day/time dependent on interest of teens and adult leaders)
- Catechist (various days/times, Sun. – Wed.)
- RCIA Sponsor (Children's Catechumenate, Sun.)

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- **Sunday Nights:** This group mixes fun and faith by emphasizing building community. The focus is on welcoming teens and inviting them to learn more about God's amazing love for them, and showing them how sharing faith can make a difference in their lives. It includes service and social activities and a last Sunday of the month supper.
- **Mini-Workcamp Service Group:** Usually the 1st Saturday of the month. Basic home repairs for those in need in our area with follow-up discussion of relevant social justice issues.
- **Small Faith Communities:** These are small groups that meet weekly to share their lives, to grow in faith, to discover their gifts and to live out their life's purpose. The groups are facilitated by adult leaders. The decision to join must be the teen's decision as it requires a personal commitment to being part of a group.
- **Catechist or Aide:** Share your faith with young people in SJN Religious Education. Those interested will be contacted by the Religious Education Coordinator.
- **RCIA Sponsor (Children's Catechumenate):** Serve as a sponsor for a child who is seeking to become a Catholic. Those interested will be contacted by the Director of RCIA/RCIC.
