We will present a formal concert at La Madeleine Church or St. Severin Church in Paris, and sing for Mass at Mont-St.-Michel and the Shrine of St. Therese of the Little Flower in Lisieux. In addition, we will celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Visitation in Annecy (the village of Annecy was home to St. Francis de Sales) and the Shrine of Rue de Bac in Paris. We may also present a formal concert at Notre Dame Cathedral in Chartres. Tour highlights include a tour of Geneva, the Basilique Notre-Dame de Fourviere in Lyon, Paray-Le-Monial, Chartres Cathedral, Mont-St.-Michel, the sites of the D-Day Landings in Normandy, Bayeux and the *Bayeux Tapestry*, Lisieux, the Louvre Museum and many of the sights synonymous with Paris, such as the Eiffel Tower and Champs Elysées.

Our choir journey promises to be a rewarding and unforgettable experience for all. We look forward to having you join us!

ITINERARY

Day 1 June 23, Saturday: Depart USA

This evening, depart Washington Dulles International Airport for your overseas journey to Geneva, via Paris CDG International Airport. Complimentary meals and beverage will be served aloft. (D)

Day 2 June 24, Sunday: Arrive Geneva – Annecy - Lyon

Upon arrival at Geneva Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim your luggage, and a Peter’s Way Tours tour manager will meet you upon your exit from Customs. Board your comfortable motor coach and soon, you will be on your way for an orientation ride of Geneva. Geneva is a cosmopolitan city in Switzerland with a population of 175,000. The city is located on the southwestern shore of Lake Geneva, and has a relaxed and graceful atmosphere. In France, the city is well known as ‘Lac Lemman.’ On your Geneva tour, you can visit the emblematic Jet d’Eau, a tall stream of water gushing from the lake, which is an elegant feature of this city. While on tour to Geneva, stroll through the Old Quarter, dotted with fountains, sculptures and frescoes. Visit the city’s oldest square, a popular gathering place known as Bourg-de-Four. Here, you can also visit the nearby St. Pierre Cathedral. Independent lunch. Continue to the Alpine village of Annecy. Annecy is magnificently situated on the Lac d’Annecy across from imposing peaks. It was the home of Saint Francis de Sales (1535-1622), Bishop of Geneva, who was exiled by the Reformation from Geneva. St. Francis de Sales and St. Jane Frances de Chantal founded the Congregation of the Visitation at Annecy in 1610. Relics of these Saints are in the Basilica of the Visitation at Annecy. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Visitation.** After Mass, we continue to Lyon for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lyon. (B,D)

Day 3 June 25, Monday: Lyon – Ars

Breakfast at your hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the **Basilique Notre-Dame de Fourvière**, which sits high atop the Fourvière Hill in Lyon. It was here, while praying, that Fr. Peter Julian Eymard experienced a revelation to found an Order devoted entirely to the worship of the Eucharist. The Basilica was built on an ancient Roman forum by the architect Pierre Bossan. Erected next to the existing Chapel of the Vierge, the basilica was constructed between 1872 and 1876. Inside, it was richly decorated to demonstrate the Church’s wealth and power. Visit the upper and lower basilica. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine.** Then, we leave Lyon and continue to Ars, to visit the Shrine of the “Cure of Ars.” **St. John Vianney**, known as the “Cure of Ars,” is the Patron Saint of Parish Priests. He was also friend and confidant of St. Peter Julian Eymard, Apostle of the Eucharist and model of Eucharistic prayer and living. Our visit offers the opportunity to thank God in a special way for all those who have responded to the call to priestly ministry. Time will be given for **prayer and reflection by the body of the Saint in the basilica at Ars.** Independent lunch.

Return to Lyon and afternoon at leisure.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lyon. (B,D)

Day 4 June 26, Tuesday: Paray-Le-Monial – Chartres

Breakfast at your hotel.

This morning, we visit Paray-Le-Monial, celebrated for the apparitions of Our Lord to **St. Margaret Mary Alacoque**, where the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Our Lord originated in the Convent of the Visitation. Visit the great Medieval church, built as the official basilica to commemorate this event, and its beautiful gardens. Late morning, we leave for Chartres. Independent lunch en route to Chartres. This afternoon, arrive in Chartres. The Cathedral spires can be seen from miles away, seeming to rise out of the wheat fields of the Beauce Plains. We will visit **Chartres Cathedral**, the jewel in the crown of Medieval churches in Europe and a testimony in stone to the religious fervor of the Middle Ages. Chartres Cathedral boasts an unrivaled expanse of sculpture, as well as one of Europe’s most impressive collections of stained-glass windows.

Late afternoon, attend a 4:00 pm formal concert at the Notre Dame Cathedral presented by the St. John Neumann Church Choir (subject to confirmation). Check-in at hotel in Chartres.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Chartres. (B,D)

Day 5 June 27, Wednesday: Mont-St.-Michel

After breakfast, we leave Chartres for Normandy. Stop for lunch en-route to Mont-St.-Michel. This afternoon, we visit the beautiful monastic architecture of Mont-St.-Michel. You will approach this tiny island by a causeway built in 1877, and enter the Medieval village of 250 inhabitants by three massive stone gates. Surrounded by the sea and soaring proudly above glistening sands, the silhouette of Mont-St.-Michel is one of the most enchanting sights in all of France. The great Benedictine Abbey Fortress that crowns this mass of granite was begun in 1017. A monastery built on three levels was added to the church’s north side in the early 13th century. **Celebrate Mass at St. Pierre Church at Mont-St.-Michel, presented by the St. John Neumann Church Choir (subject to confirmation).**

Continue to Bayeux for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Bayeux. (B,D)

Day 6 June 28, Thursday: Landing Beaches - Bayeux

After breakfast, we will visit the sites of the D-Day Landings, the Allied invasion of Normandy on June 6, 1944. Our first stop will be **Pointe du Hoc**, the enemy command post of the entire invasion front, which is filled with monuments and memorials. We continue with a **walk on Omaha Beach**, where we will view the **U.S. Monument**. Our D-Day sightseeing concludes with a poignant visit to the **American Military Cemetery of St. Laurent**, where over 9,000 Americans who died in the Normandy campaign are buried. Time will be given for prayer and reflection at the site.

Continue to Bayeux, a city rich in Norman history and the first French town to be liberated during the D-Day Invasion, on June 7, 1944. Time will be given for an independent lunch in Bayeux. Following lunch, visit the Gothic **Cathedrale Notre-Dame**, and the **Musée de la Tapiserie de Bayeux**, which houses the

spectacular *Bayeux Tapestry*. One of the most famous tapestries in the world, it is actually embroidered on a band of linen, 231 feet long and 20 inches wide. The tapestry depicts some 58 scenes in eight colors, which tells the story of the conquest of England by William the Conqueror. Late afternoon, we continue to Lisieux. Upon arrival, check in to hotel.
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Bayeux. (B,D)

Day 7 June 29, Friday: Lisieux - Paris

Breakfast at hotel. Our morning tour begins in Lisieux, the home of St. Thérèse, during the second phase of her life, after the death of her mother, Bl. Zélie Martin. We will visit Les Buissonnets (*Little Bushes*), the humble dwelling of this modern-day Saint until she entered the Carmel Convent at the tender age of 15. Upon entering the convent chapel in Lisieux, you will sense a deep communion with St. Thérèse who lived here from 1888 through 1897. Pilgrims can venerate the remains of St. Thérèse in the Chapel of the Reliquary. Above the reliquary is a statue of the Virgin Mary, the same statue that cured Thérèse by 'her beautiful smile' on May 13, 1883 at her home in Les Buissonnets. We will also visit the Gothic Norman Cathedral of St. Peter (parish church of the Martin Family), and the astonishing Basilica of St. Thérèse, and the Crypt Chapel. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Therese, sung by the St. John Neumann Church Choir (subject to confirmation).** Independent lunch.

This afternoon, we continue for Paris, the "City of Lights."
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Paris. (B,D)

Day 8 June 30, Saturday: AM/Highlights Tour of Paris - PM/Louvre Museum

After breakfast, our guide will bring alive the remarkable sights of this magnificent and Romantic city on the River Seine. Visit the Ile de la Cité, where you will visit the magnificent cathedral, Notre-Dame-de-Paris. Its massive flying buttresses, famous towers, and elegant rose windows will take your breath away. Continue to visit the nearby Sainte Chapelle, a masterpiece of flamboyant Gothic architecture built by Saint Louis in the heart of the Palais de la Cité on the Ile de la Cité in Paris. Discover its unique stained-glass windows rendering the air iridescent with light and color, symbols of the heavenly Jerusalem. Then, pass by the Eiffel Tower, Champs Elysées, Arc de Triomphe, Tomb of Napoleon, Place de la Concorde, Place de la Bastille (home of the Opéra Bastille) and The Place des Vosges, the oldest square in Paris and one of the most beautiful in the world. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, visit the world famous Louvre museum, which boasts nearly 60,000 square meters of exhibition space to house its vast collection. The Louvre showcases artifacts, sculptures, paintings and drawings representing eleven millennia of history. In the sculpture wing, you can see the famed *Venus de Milo* and *Winged Victory of Samothrace*. The many galleries of paintings include works from noted masters such as Rembrandt, Rubens, Raphael, Titian, and others, as well as da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*. Independent dinner.
Overnight at hotel in Paris. (B)

Day 9 July 1, Sunday: AM/Rue De Bac; St. Vincent de Paul & Montmartre- PM/Concert at St. Severin in Paris

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, you will be transferred to the Rue de Bac, and the Chapel at the motherhouse of the Daughters of Charity where St. Catherine Labouré had her first meeting with Our Lady in 1830. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine of the Miraculous Medal.** The apparitions began on the night of July 18, 1830. The young nun was awakened by a small angel who told her to come to the Chapel; the Blessed Virgin is waiting for you. Catherine dressed and did so, and found the chapel fully lit. Here, the Virgin Mary spoke with Catherine for nearly two hours. Then we will continue to the nearby Shrine of St. Vincent de Paul, to pray beside the body of the Saint. Continue to visit the fascinating Artist Square and Sacré Coeur Basilica, with its huge bell tower and onion-shaped domes-one of the city's most familiar sights. This gleaming white church rises atop Montmartre, Paris' highest hill at 423 feet. Independent lunch.

Around 4:00 pm, you will be transferred to the Church of St. Severin for rehearsal and 5:00 pm a concert presented by the St. John Neumann Church Choir (subject to confirmation). Dinner and overnight at hotel in Paris. (B,D)

Day 10 July 2, Monday: Paris - USA

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Paris CDG International Airport for your return flight to Washington Dulles International Airport. (B)

- U.S. departure tax; Customs user fee; security tax and all airport departure taxes.
- Meeting and assistance upon departure from Washington Dulles International Airport.
- Eight (8) nights' accommodations in twin-rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout.
- Breakfast daily plus seven (7) dinners, as per attached itinerary. (All dinners are three-course set menu.) Mineral water, coffee and tea are not included during dinners.
- Services of a Peter's Way Tours government-licensed, English-speaking tour manager/guide upon arrival to departure in France.
- All sightseeing as per the attached itinerary, including overseas arrival and departure transfers, in a private, air-conditioned motor coach.
- Entrance fees to all sites, as per attached itinerary.
- Portage of one piece of luggage per person at hotels throughout your tour.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check or money order only. In an effort to keep prices as low as possible, the package price reflects a cash discount. However, it is possible to make your final payment via MasterCard, Visa, Discover, or American Express. A \$100.00 convenience fee will apply to all packages paid by credit card. Invoices and credit card authorization forms will be included with your welcome document. The credit card form must be completed in entirety in order for the transaction to be approved. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package rate or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. dollar in excess of 5% from print date. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will be required.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round-trip from Washington Dulles via Air France. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Airfare is subject to increases prior to date of travel. By sending your deposit together with your completed reservation form before the deposit deadline, airfare will be guaranteed against future fare increases excluding tax increases or fuel surcharges. Tax estimation is based on increases imposed by airlines is subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). (see LATE RESERVATIONS) Airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can be made at time of check-in only. If you are a member of the frequent flyer or affiliate program, please bring your account card to the airport on the day of departure to receive proper mileage credit. Peter's Way Tours cannot submit seating preferences or frequent flyer information as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms, with private facilities, in hotels throughout your tour. Triple rooms are also available. We discourage triple room accommodations because they're normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double-bedded rooms with a cot or rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of \$795.00. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin rooms and are sometimes located away from the group in a different area of the hotel, and may be in high traffic areas, such as stairways/elevators. We do not like to assess an additional charge for the single traveler and will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancelling, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Breakfast daily plus seven (7) dinners, as per attached itinerary. (All dinners are three-course set menu.) Mineral water, coffee and tea are not included during dinners. Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

SIGHTSEEING AND ENTRANCE FEES: All sightseeing, as per itinerary, aboard a private motor coach with the services of a professional, licensed, English-speaking guide. Entrance fees to all sights are included.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package

(\$2,495.00 per person sharing a twin room) must notify Peter's Way Tours in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. *Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the land only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus.*

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: Due to bus space, one carry-on bag and one checked bag, per person, are permitted. Standard airline baggage policies usually allow checked baggage up to 62 total inches and range to 50 pounds and carry-on baggage up to 45 total inches and 11 to 40 pounds. However, policies may vary from the time of printing of this brochure. Contact your airline directly before departure for current baggage dimension allowances. For luggage exceeding the allowed limits, excess baggage fees will apply at check-in. Our final documents will contain current information applicable to your designated airline.

TRANSFER AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip private overseas transfers to/from hotel. Portage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels. Although the airlines will allow you to check two pieces of luggage, we strongly suggest that you travel with one suitcase and one carry-on.

SERVICE CHARGES FOR ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries (All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure). Deviation fee will apply, plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability. Special delivery charges incurred will also be due in advance.

PASSENGERS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS: The majority of our trips require a lot of walking, which may involve stairs, hills, cobblestone roads and uneven pavement. Additionally, most motor coaches are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. It is each passenger's responsibility to be aware of his or her limits with regard to travel and group activities. Any person with a disability requiring special attention must advise Peter's Way Tours of the situation at time of enrollment. A qualified companion must accompany any passenger requiring special assistance. Peter's Way Tours will make reasonable attempts to accommodate disabled passengers with special needs, but shall not be held responsible in the event we are unable to do so. Moreover, Peter's Way Tours is not responsible for the denial of services by any carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, the cancellation fee will be \$350.00 per person. For cancellations received from 99 days prior up to the day of departure the cancellation fee will be 100% of package price per person including taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviations fees and any other costs incurred (if applicable). TIPPING: For good work, recommended (but voluntary) tipping to your driver is Euro 2.00 per passenger per day; to the tour manager/guide Euro 4.00 per passenger per day, for the local guides Euro 1.50 per passenger per day. Tips for the bus driver and tour manager/guide are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: All passengers must ensure that they are medically and physically fit for travel and that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others as pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, climbing up/down stairs, etc. Any passenger who is physically challenged must submit a certificate from his/her medical doctor stating that he/she is capable of taking part in this pilgrimage without assistance. If special assistance is required, the passenger must travel with a companion willing and capable of providing any necessary assistance.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is strongly recommended that all participants buy insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for lost or damaged luggage or trip interruption. Peter's Way Tours offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan. These benefits and services help insure the well being of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The plan payments are based on total package price, including departure taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc. The plan payment for total package prices from \$0 to \$2,100.00 is \$139; \$2,101.00 to \$3,000.00 is \$175.00; from \$3,001.00 and over is \$199.00. **If the plan payment is made at the time of deposit or within 10 days of receiving the Peter's Way Tours "Tour Deposit Acknowledgment Letter," the passenger will be covered for pre-existing conditions. However, the insurance plan can be purchased at anytime thereafter, excluding Coverage for pre-existing conditions, until final payment has been made. Plan payments will not be accepted after final payment has been made.
